She sits on a board for "Common Weal Community Arts Inc". She is on the youth committee for a local youth group. She is looking into a suicide prevention program.

She does acting on local shows that come to Regina, and works behind the scenes, (production secretary for Moccasin Flats season 1 and Assistant Production Coordinator for Moccasin Flats season 2). She produced a movie called "A Life Less Empty", the main actors are Dakota House and Nathaniel Acran, the movie is still in the process of being filmed.

She has also gone to the University of Greenwich in London, England on 2006.

She is currently in the process of opening up her own business called Glacsy Model Management Canada.

She is coordinatong a fashion show in Regina(all proceeds go to the cystic Fibrosis Foundation). She is also coordinating a fashion show that will be held at the Annual First Nations University Pow-wow in Regina April 4, 2009.
